By pledging to take action now, your organisation is making a commitment towards delivering the following core principles:

- 1. Create and deliver a Climate Change Action Plan to achieve net-zero by 2040
- 2. Plan for the impacts of climate change
- 3. Act as leaders throughout Rotherham in relation to climate and nature crises
- 4. Rethink the materials we buy and use refuse, reduce, reuse, repurpose and recycle
- 5. Work towards the removal of single-use plastics from our operations
- 6. Collaborate with partners, share our knowledge, and promote work that is taking place
- 7. Support our local supply chains and encourage green regional growth
- 8. Protect nature and support its recovery
- 9. Encourage others in Rotherham to reduce their impact on the environment
- 10. Be transparent set targets and report on them
